Community Leader Scholarship

Scholarship Description

This scholarship is to be awarded to an undergraduate Muscogee (Creek) student who is currently attending an institution of higher education or is a first-time entering freshman and who has exhibited leadership qualities while in a school setting. In the school setting, a student leader maximizes the strengths of the student community, balances the needs of the student community while moving forward, builds relationships and works together with the student community, mobilizes student community, leads by example, practices school stewardship, accountable to the student community, thinks forward to incoming classes, recruits and mentors new student leaders to sustain the student community, and walks beside the student community while leading.

Amount of Scholarship Award **\$1000.00**

Purpose and Application of Funds

The purpose of this scholarship is to financially assist Muscogee (Creek) Nation students that might not otherwise have the financial means to further their education. This scholarship award can be utilized to pay for the *required* cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, supplies, testing or examination fees, transportation, or other incidental required cost related to the cost of the post-secondary education institution. This scholarship is to be awarded to a Muscogee (Creek) Nation undergraduate student who is attending an institution of higher education, a technical or vocational trade school.

Eligibility Guidelines

1. Must be an enrolled citizen of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation.
2. Must be currently attending an institution of higher education or enrolled as a first-time entering freshman.
3. Must agree to authorize the Scholarship Foundation Program to publicize the scholarship award if selected.
