Muscogee Creek Nation At-Large California Scholarship

Scholarship Description

The Muscogee Creek At-Large California Community is the largest populations of Muscogee Creek outside of Oklahoma, numbering an estimated 2,000 citizens. This scholarship fund was gathered through donations at a meeting of California Creek held in Irvine, California.

While currently this scholarship is a one-time award facilitated by organizers of the event, it is hoped that the concentrated effort of the Creek Community in California will enable future awards.

Amount of Scholarship Award **\$600.00** **(Fall Semester 2019)**

Purpose and Application of Funds

This scholarship award can be utilized to pay for the *required* cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, supplies, testing or examination fees, transportation, or other incidental required cost related to the cost of the post-secondary education institution. The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize and award a graduating Muscogee (Creek) Nation high school student that resided in California and will be attending college or trade school.

Eligibility Guidelines

1. Must be an enrolled citizen of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation.
2. Must reside in California and a current graduating senior. .
3. Must have completed a Scholarship Foundation Program Application,
4. Must be enrolled as a full-time and first-time entering student.
5. Must demonstrate financial need.
6. Must agree to authorize the Scholarship Foundation Program to publicize the scholarship award if selected.
